RE:	Changes to LTC Outbreak Data Collection Process	5

The Long-Term Care Inspections Branch would like to provide long-term care (LTC) home licensees and staff with an update on how the ministry will be collecting COVID-19 outbreak information as of December 12, 2022.

To streamline the process of sharing COVID-19 outbreak status updates, a new LTC home **self-reporting** process will replace the current method of collecting statistical data via frequent calls with ministry staff.

Once implemented, this new **mandatory** reporting system will allow homes to quickly and easily submit daily outbreak data using the Health Data Collection Service (HDCS) website. All LTC homes already have access to this website for submitting other reporting requirements to the ministry, such as the quarterly LTC staffing data collection. Please note, this does not affect the continued requirement to report outbreaks in the Critical Incident Reporting (CIS) system.

Training and guidance material will be provided in December to all LTC homes to prepare for the transition to the new self-reporting process. All LTC home staff that are responsible for reporting outbreak data are strongly encouraged to participate in **one** of the training sessions, on:

Tuesday December 6, 2022 (1:00 – 2:00 pm) **Thursday December 8, 2022** (10:00 – 11:00 am)

To register for one of the sessions, please complete the registration form found here.

The training sessions will be recorded for reference in the future and for those unable to attend one of the training sessions.

Every long-term care home's Administrator and Director of Care will automatically be given access to the COVID-19 LTC Outbreak web form in HDCS on December 12, 2022. Each home will then ensure that additional key personnel in their home have access to this form.

To be able to submit COVID-19 LTC Outbreak data for your home:

- **new users** of HDCS will need create an account on their own by following the instructions in the attached HDCS Self-Registration Guide (refer to Appendix A) by Thursday December 8th.
- existing users who have access to HDCS, and are not an LTC home Administrator or Director of Care, should contact <u>askhealthdata@ontario.ca</u> by Thursday December 8 to request the COVID-19 LTC Outbreak form be added to their home's profile.

Any future new users should follow the self-registration guide and allow for two business days for their accounts to be activated.

As you are aware, the real-time collection of this data has been and continues to be a critical part of monitoring the status of COVID-19's impact on LTC homes. As a result of your continued cooperation, a number of stakeholders within the government and the broader health and research sectors have access to timely data that helps to inform decision making and policy development.
