We are providing the attached fact sheet to clarify the application of Ontario Regulation 146/20 under the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020* to student placements in long-term care homes and in other health service provider settings (O. Reg. 146/20). The fact sheet provides information to assist long-term care home licensees, health service providers and post-secondary institutions to support these student placements during the COVID-19 pandemic in a manner consistent with O. Reg. 146/20 and public health guidance to ensure sustainability of Ontario's health care workforce while ensuring public safety.

The O. Reg. 146/20 focuses on the employment status of individuals performing work in a long-term care home or other health service provider setting. The requirements in O. Reg. 146/20 are not specifically intended to capture students in placements; however, there are circumstances in which they may apply to student placements in these settings.

Stakeholders are encouraged to seek independent legal advice related to O. Reg. 146/20 and how it may apply to particular circumstances. The fact sheet is designed to provide general information and is not intended to constitute legal advice.
