RE: **New Inspector Testing Protocol**

A new testing protocol for Long-Term Care Home Inspectors is being implemented in order to align with the recent Minister's Directive— COVID-19: Long-term care home surveillance testing and access to homes. The protocol is effective December 9th, 2020 with an implementation allowance to December 16th, 2020.

This testing protocol requires long-term care home inspectors to confirm that they have received a negative COVID-19 test result prior to entering homes and to verbally attest to not subsequently having tested positive. The frequency with which inspectors are required to be tested varies depending on the status of the home they are inspecting—the requirements are similar to those outlined in the Minister's Directive:

- If an inspector is entering a long-term care home in public health unit regions in green-prevent or **yellow-protect** levels, they shall be tested every two weeks,
- If an inspector is entering a long-term care home in public health unit regions in orangerestrict, red-control or grey-lockdown levels, they shall be tested every week.

Inspectors will keep an official record of all (negative or positive) COVID-19 test results and will verbally attest to a negative COVID-19 test upon entering a home.
