Separate Agreement (sample template) for Ontario Long Term Care Homes

Instruction Notes to Users (yellow to be deleted prior to signing agreement):

- This sample language is to assist LTCH in the development of a mutually agreeable separate agreement with a vendor under the Government of Ontario's enterprise-wide Vendor of Record.
- This document is a starting point only and is not a complete legal agreement nor does it represent business or legal advice from Ontario.
- The VOR Master Agreement provides rights and obligations that are customized for and applicable only to Ontario and that will not, therefore, apply to your organization unless you amend the Agreement by adding terms under (b) below.
- The term of the separate agreement should not exceed the term of the master agreement (Dec 1, 2021)

Background:

The Vendor and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario, as represented by the Minister of Government and Consumer Services, have entered into a Master Agreement for [Security Guard Services or Temporary Help Services] made as of [Insert date].

In order to place orders and acquire Services and Deliverables from the Vendor, the Buyer must enter into a separate agreement with the Vendor that will adopt some terms and conditions of the Master Agreement and include further specific Buyer amendments (business, legal and policy) to enable a legal relationship to exist between the Buyer and Vendor.

(b) Amendments:

The following provisions of the Master Agreement will be amended for the purposes of the Separate Agreement:

- (i) The terms Client, ministry, ministry representative, Ontario Public Service, Her Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario replaced with Long Term Care Home "Buyer".
- (ii) LTCH note: that if your intent of payment is not a Purchasing Card or Direct Deposit to the Vendor that needs to be identified here. Also replace direct deposit instructions with yours here.
- (iii) **LTCH note:** there may be terms that are required by your organization that you want to add here
